This data has been transcribed with the utmost care - however no guarantee of accuracy is given.

This information has been gleaned from various tombstone readings, Bovina New UP interment records (from 1910), 1855 and 1905 Bovina Census and the genealogy notes from the sources provided in "Early Bovina Families & their Descendants".

A few individuals appear to be buried in two locations. When David F. Hoy did his readings (1914-1918) I am certain that the tombstones were there. Some families moved their loved ones to the new cemetery before the Cemetery Association incorporated (1910) and no known record of the transfer exists, but the tombstones were read in the Bovina New UP Cemetery also.

## **A LEGACY OF DAVID FLETCHER HOY**

Born: October 6, 1863 at Bovina Center, New York

Died: December 6, 1930 at Ithaca, New York

David Fletcher Hoy was Registrar of Students at Cornell University, Ithaca, New York. During the years of 1913 through 1919 he made many visits to his home town and conducted a comprehensive survey of the burial sites in the town of Bovina. Most of these cemeteries are no longer used for burials. There may be other unrecorded burial places, as loved family members were often laid to rest on the family homestead.

His data includes many references to family relationships not included on the gravestones. He also compiled a listing of the “early Bovina Families”. His great interest in the family relationships is shown by the tremendous amount of information gathered for genealogy records.

Regarding his own family, he selected his four great-grandfathers:

**James Hoy** – **John Robertson** – **Thomas Miller** – **Thomas Turnbull** and traced their descendants through four and five generations.

Upon the death of David Fletcher Hoy, much of his data came into the capable hands of his grandson, David Fletcher Hoy III, his niece, Vera Davidson Storie, and his nephew, Howard Fletcher Davidson, all of whom continued with the momentous task of data compilation and record updating.

Most of the original data is now in the safe-keeping of David Fletcher Hoy III of Tucson, AZ, and Edwin Douglas Davidson and Richard Thomas Davidson residing in San Diego, California. Copies of a majority of the originals are now in the possession of Ray LaFever, Bovina Town Historian. This database is presented to make the information more readily available to others who may be researching genealogical records. Every effort has been made to accurately transcribe the data from the notes of David Fletcher Hoy into this document. I also used the “Bovina record of interments” as cross-reference.

## **THE JOHN ARCHIBALD CEMETERY**

“This cemetery is located about two miles above the Bovina, N.Y. post office on the John Archibald farm now occupied by Thomas Boggs. It is below the road just before you come to the house. It is inclosed by a wall. There are no headstones. No. 6 ( James Russell) and No. 7 (Betsy Patterson Archibald Russell) are not buried within the inclosure, but nearer the house. I visited the place in June 1917.”

Turn right on **Boggs Road** for 0.4 miles. The cemetery is located at bearing **025 degrees** at **two yards** on the left of the road. It is overgrown with brambles and difficult to locate.

## **THE BALLENTYNE CEMETERY**

“This cemetery is located by the line fence between Claude Wright and Bloemeke farms, no record yet.”

Proceed northeast on Delaware County Route 6 (through Bovina Center) for 4.7 miles. Turn left on **New Road** for 0.2 miles to the line fence on the left. The cemetery is located bearing **300 degrees** at **120 yards**, to the left of the line fence.

**--July 31, 1998--**

This cemetery is enclosed within a rectangular stone walled area. The location is quite heavily wooded, and is difficult to locate. Within the enclosure are two marked grave stones and there are several field stones which are presumed to be grave markers.

“Was located in the northeast corner of orchard on the Irvine farm. Moved to the new cemetery at Bovina Center.”

Two stones remain, leaning against an arborvitae tree. Area is overgrown with brush and brambles.

August 2005 - Unable to locate the two stones this year. The stonewall fence line is over whelmed by dry leaves and fallen branches.

## **THE BURGIN FARM CEMETERY**

“This cemetery is situated on the Burgin farm about one and one-half miles below Bovina Center, NY. There is but one stone but quite a large number are buried there. Probably by the names of Hollister, Purdy, Halstead, perhaps Burgin. Copied by D F Hoy 1915. Outside the wall, on the northeast side of the cemetery, are stones for the aunt and uncle of Robert Halstead.”

“This cemetery was located about one-fourth mile from the end of Lake Delaware on the farm of Robert J Livingston. (Now owned by his grandson, Peter Goelet Gerry). The lake is situated about three miles from Bovina Center, NY and about one-half mile from the hamlet of Lake Delaware, locally known as " The Hook".The bodies were a few years ago removed to Bovina Center and placed in the new U P cemetery at that place.

The families of Scutt, Light, and Close used this cemetery.”

## NICHOLS CEMETERY

“This cemetery is in the northeastern part of the town of Bovina, N.Y. Take the main road out of Bovina Center. At Bovina, (or Butt End), take the left road. At Maynards schoolhouse take the left road. After passing the farm of Joshua Hobbie, take the left road and the cemetery is on the right about ten rods from the turn. This cemetery is one of the earliest in the town. At one time contained many graves. Some have been moved to the cemetery at Bovina Center. Many graves are unmarked. Some are marked with field stones with initials cut on them. I visited the place in September 1918 and found it grown over by bushes and in a neglected condition. I listed all the stones. The following persons are supposed to be buried there. The data given in this list is not to be assumed to be on the stone. Names marked with a "#" have stones. Names marked with "?" are supposed to be buried there as recorded in other records.”

## REFORMED PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH CEMETERY

“Bovina is a small hamlet about four miles above Bovina Center, NY. The church was known as the "Old Stone Church" and has not been standing for years. The new church is at Bovina Center. The dates were copied in October 1914 and burials are still being made in the cemetery. Copied by James Crosier for David F Hoy.”

The new Reformed Presbyterian Church mentioned above was located where the new firehouse stands in Bovina Center.

## **SNOOKS FARM CEMETERY [Vacated]**

“This cemetery was located on the Snooks farm about one quarter mile from Lake Delaware, NY. This hamlet, locally known as "The Hook" is about three miles below Bovina Center, NY. A few years ago the bodies were removed to Delhi, NY and placed in the Woodland cemetery at Delhi, NY.

The people who were probably buried there were Henry Snooks and his wife, Mary Laing and probably others by the name of Northrup.”

Starting at the intersection of New York State Route 28 and Delaware County Route 6:

Proceed northwest on New York State Route 28 towards Delhi, NY for 1.1 miles. Just after crossing the bridge over the Little Delaware River, turn right on old NY Route 28, right again at **Lee Hollow** and proceed for .6 miles. Cemetery was located on the right, bearing **180 degrees** at **70 yards**, near a large locust tree. The property passed from Snooks to Jacob Bailey to John W Scott.

There may have been another burial site on the Forman farm .08 miles past the Snooks site. Bearing **110 degrees** at **20 yards**.

## **THE NEW BOVINA U P CHURCH CEMETERY**

“The cemetery was started in 1849 and then known as the "New UP cemetery of Bovina, NY". A few years ago it was incorporated (1910). It is situated southeast of Bovina Center, NY and about one mile distant from the village. The data was collected in 1916 by Thomas Gordon at the expense of David F Hoy, Ithaca, NY. The matter in brackets has been inserted by David F Hoy as a means of identification. All stones are lined up north and south. The list begins at the east side and takes row by row. “

## **RANGES, LOTS and GRAVES IN THE NEW BOVINA UP CEMETERY**

**RANGES** - [20 feet wide], run from east to west beginning at the south boundary.

**LOTS** – [10 feet wide], run from south to north within each range.

**GRAVES**--are numbered from the south end of each lot.

**So - Range 01, Lot 01, Grave 01 is the most southeasterly burial in this cemetery.**  
**(prior to gaining the new LaFever area).**

Various pathways and parks are laid out in the cemetery. In some cases, marble corner markers, reading “ Perpetual care” are used to show the extent of the burial plot. In other places, iron stakes are used.

SECTION A -There are *four* ranges south of the roadway.

SECTION B – There are *five* ranges south of the roadway.

SECTION C – Contains the entry road and the grassy area between the road and west wall.

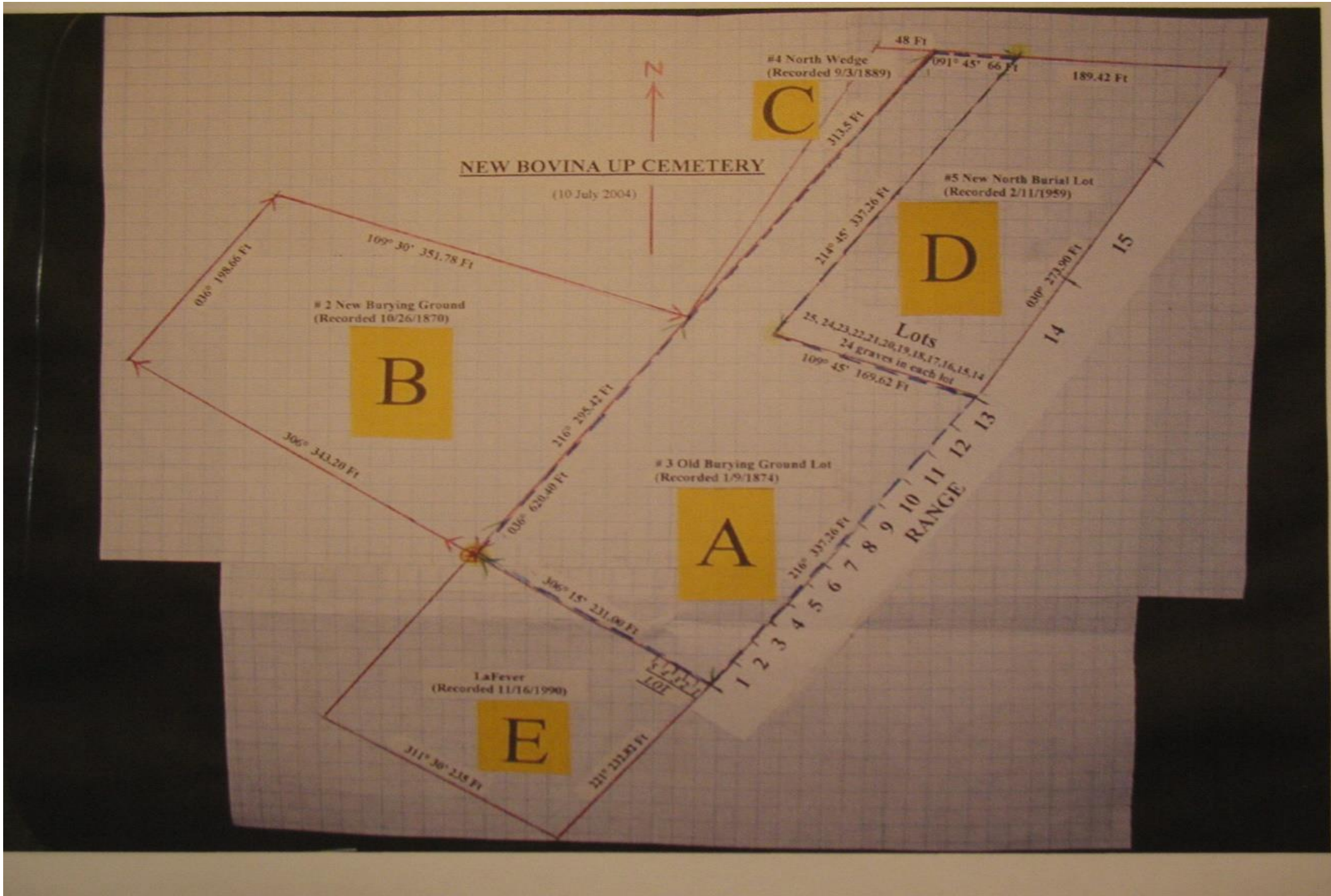
SECTION D - The layout is changed.

Range 14 is approximately 100 feet wide. The Lot numbers start with Lot 14 and extend through Lot 25. containing 24 graves each.

Range 15 is not yet in use, but is laid out similar to Range 14.
