Despite the early loss of her family, Mrs. Adler persevered in operating the farm and carrying on an active life. She continued operating the farm doing all of the chores and running her own errands until she was well into her 80s.

Forty some years ago she was united in marriage to Joseph Woolheater of Kelly Corners and to this union were born two children, Leon Woolheater of Kelly Corners, who conducts the old homestead farm, and Leslie E. Woolheater, who conducts a general store at Andes.

She was a woman well and favorably known, as there were but few homes in the community in which she lived that she had not been for some good purpose, for if some one was needed to stay with any member of a family as company or for other purposes she was called and did it with a spirit that made one feel that she was doing so willingly. Her husband, who is mentioned above, died about thirty years ago, leaving her with a very young family. She conducted the farm by hiring hired help and during her later years it was conducted by her son mentioned. She leaves two sisters, Mrs. Estella Oliver of Bovina Center and Mrs. D. H. Gray of Merrifield, near Auburn; two half-brothers, Weed Dumond of Margaretville and Lavern at Lake Delaware. The children have lost a good mother and the neighborhood in which she lived have lost a good neighbor. Mrs. Rosa was the daughter of John and Elizabeth Barber Story and was born in Broad Street Hollow near Allaben, September 19, 1866. She lived a part of her life there, being married to Elbert Rosa March 14, 1885. About 28 years ago they moved to Delaware County.

Mrs. Rosa was a woman well liked and was of a amiable personality. She was a loving and devoted mother and a god neighbor, always willing to lend a helping hand.

Besides her husband she leaves the following children: Mrs. Emery Rider of Delhi, Mrs Will D. Of this union there were two sons, James, now deceased, and William who resides near Fleischmanns. Her husband passed away March 2, 1902.

Mr. and Mrs. Morrison were among the first in this vicinity to embark in the business of keeping summer boarders. They built the present Maple Grove house and were successful.

When they retired from the summer hotel business, they erected a beautiful residence on Main Street. Here Mrs. Morrison lived until she sold the property. In 1921 she erected a bungalow near the homes of her children on the Halcott road.

Mrs. Morrison was a member of the M.E. church in Fleischmanns and took great interest in church work having been on of the stewards of the church for a number of years. At the age of 80 years she was one of the oldest surviving members of the original Griffin Corners congregation that built the Fleischmanns church.

She caught a slight cold and was ill only a few days. The funeral services were conducted at the M.E. church by Rev. W. W. Williams. Interment in the family plot at the Clovesville cemetery.
