Whence the above bounden John Barnett & Stephen Voorhis administrators and administrators as aforesaid have lately made application to the Surrogate of the county of Orleans, for authority to sell the real estate of the said deceased, to enable them to pay his debts, and proceedings are now pending before the said Surrogate, for an order authorizing such sale, now the condition of their obligation is such, that if the above bounden John Barnett and Stephen Voorhis shall pay all the monies arising from such sale, after deducting the expenses thereof, and shall deliver all moneys taken by them on such sale, to the said Surrogate, within twenty days after the same shall have been received, and taken by them, then their obligation to be void, otherwise of force
