

To the Honorable Charles Mathraway Surrogate  
of the County of Delaware -

The return of the proceedings of the sale of the Real Estate of  
Jacob Voorhis Deceased. We John Barnett administrators  
and Triphena Voorhis administrators of the goods and  
chattels rights and credits of the said deceased do hereby  
make return of the said proceedings and Report  
as follows -

That in pursuance of the order of the said  
Surrogate bearing date the fifth day of July  
1842 we did on the tenth day of instant Octom-  
ber on the premises in the town of Davenport  
in the County of Delaware between the hours of nine  
o'clock in the Morning and the setting of the sun  
on that day sell at public vendue the whole of  
the premises in the said order described to  
Michael Fletcher Lebulow E. Goodrich and  
John Sherman for the sum of twenty dollars  
which was the highest sum that was bid for  
the same and that a greater sum cannot  
be obtained and that the time and place of  
such sale were previously published for  
six weeks in a newspaper printed in said  
County and posted in three of the most  
public places in the said town of Davenport  
and further that the said sale was in all  
respects conducted fairly and bonafide.
