

The People of the State of New York to Henry Mackay of the town of Roxbury in the County of Delaware; Whereas Triphum Voorhis, an administratrix and John Barnet administrators of the estate of Jacob Voorhis deceased late of the said County, deceased, have presented a petition to Charles Hattaway Surrogate of our County of Delaware for authority to mortgage loan or sell the real estate of the said deceased, and setting forth that Harriet wife of the said Henry Mackay, and Lovisa Voorhis heirs of the said Jacob Voorhis are minors, and whereas due notice has been served on the said minors that the said administratrix and administrators would on this fifth day of May 1842 apply to have some disinterested freeholder appointed guardian to the said minors for the sole purpose of appearing for and taking care of their interest in the proceedings, and the said minors have neglected to appear according to the said notice. Therefore the Surrogate aforesaid in pursuance of the power in me vested by the Statutes of this State and an order by me made and entered, do hereby appoint you the said Henry Mackay a disinterested freeholder, guardian of the said minors for the sole purpose of appearing for and taking care of the interests of the said minors in the proceedings.
