County of Delaware & State of N.Y.

Witnesseth, That the said party of the first part, in consideration of the sum of
Seven Dollars,

to them duly paid, have sold, and

By these Presents, do grant and convey to the said party of the second
part her heirs and assigns, All that piece or parcel of land
situated in Canajoharie Town County & State aforesaid
and being a Cuntry lot. Beginning at a chestnut post
next to the brick wall between Henry Durfis land and
that of the said Webster and at the South west corner
of a Cuntry lot owned by Thomas Davis running
thence westerly along said wall fourteen feet to a chestnut
post thence Northerly Ten feet thence Easterly fourteen
feet thence southerly Thence Ten feet to the place of
beginning containing 140 square feet of land. The said
corner of said lots all being at right angles.

With the Appurtenances, and all the Estate, Title and Interest therein of the said part^{as} of the first part. And the said Jonathan Webster and Eliza Webster do hereby covenant and agree to and with the said part^{of} of the second part, their heirs and assigns, that the premises thus conveyed in the Quiet and Peaceable Possession of the said part^{of} of the second part, their heirs and assigns will forever Warrant and Defend against any person whomsoever lawfully claiming the same, or any part thereof.
