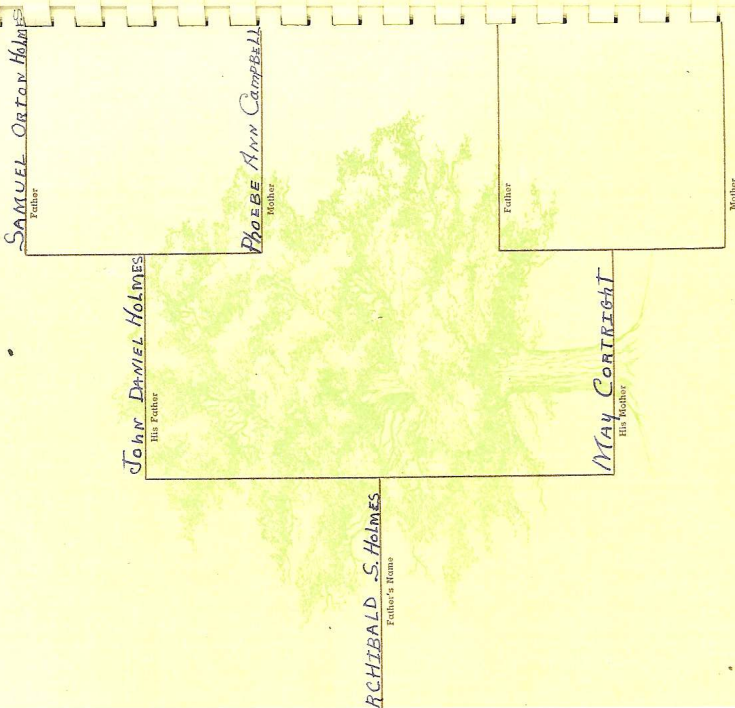

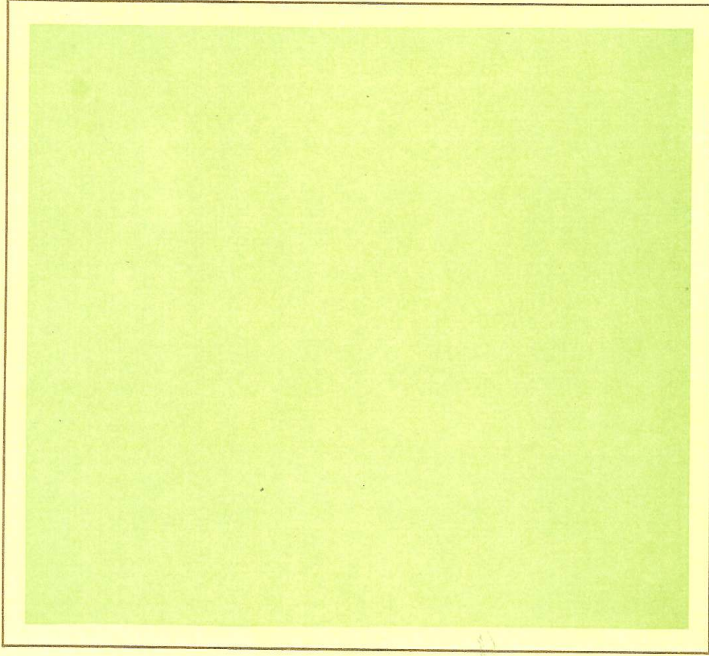
FATHER'S FAMILY TREE
