He was educated in the Troy schools, reared to farm labor, and was his father's assistant until the death of the latter in 1887. He then inherited the farm, which is one of the best cultivated and most beautifully situated of any in the county. It occupies an eminence overlooking the valley of the Hudson River and the cities of Troy, Cohoes and Albany. With well-kept fields and orchards, comfortable house and tasteful grounds, it is an ideal home. Mr. Betts was formerly a member of the school board, before the section in which he now resides became a part of the city of Troy. He belongs to the Methodist Episcopal Church, and is a member of the Masonic fraternity, belonging to lodge, chapter and commandery of Knights Templar; is also a member of the Shrine.
